The Results of the Scans Are Back!

At the end of April I completed the second round of passive immune therapy at Vanderbilt Hospital in Nashville, TN. I had to wait a month for the scans to be done the end of May. I just met today with the doctors to get my tests results.

I have Good News to share! While **the growth behind my stomach** is still around 40% of the original size- **there is no more active cancer in that growth!** So that is a big victory! **The growth on my collarbone** - though only around ¼ of the original size - is **still has active cancer** though. There is some soreness and swelling that has recently appeared in that area. It might be an infection or even sign that the growth is dying! I will have another scan run this coming Monday afternoon to determine the cause.

I am doing well enough that I will not need any more treatments and the small amount of cancer that remains is contained. I will have scans done again in 3 months and I need to give myself some more time to "build myself up!" I will now put more focus on detoxing my system this summer. I will also hold off on "International Endeavors" for the summer months to regain my strength. This will create some additional schedule changes and grace needed for some venues. But hey, I need to take care of myself!

As I have stated before, Michal Ann and I are committed to the journey of going towards great health! III John 1:2 states, "May you prosper and be in health even as your soul prospers!" We claim that one for every aspect of our lives!
